



The site is situated in Vidnappen. When standing by the church, follow Mulevegen past the «Salem» meeting house. Follow the main road until you see the sign «Langedalen». Go up to the Vessel Traffic Service Centre. Most of the ruins are located along the road past the centre. **Please close gates behind you, there are sheep in the area!**



Fedje during WWII

Fedje was one of two radar stations for the Luftwaffe in the Bergen-area.

The German navy took charge of the aerial defense around Bergen and Trondheim during the war.

In Bergen, many heavy air defense batteries were mounted in 1940.

A battery for practice was established on Fedje in January of 1942. It had two cannons.

Later in the war, Fedje was promoted to an independent artillery battery and two additional cannons were mounted.

The Fedje Battery often found itself in combat with allied aircraft.



Demining Fedje

During the Spring of Peace in 1945, the 873 mines on Fedje were cleared. British and Norwegian officers took charge.

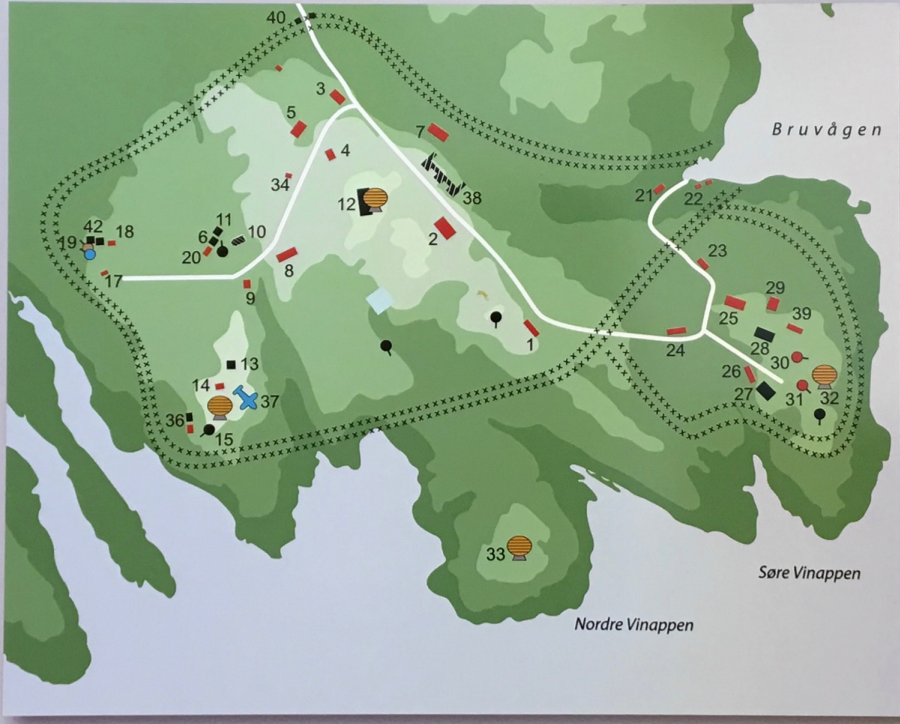
